

## **Proposed Assessment for Tourism Awareness Transition Year Programme**

As a result of consultation at a recent in-service it was proposed that the Tourism Awareness Transition Year Programme should be assessed by a portfolio of course work. It was suggested that this might include a selection of samples of work undertaken during the term/year eg. assignments, a project, brochures, questionnaires, a self evaluation report, terminal written examinations, etc.

### **Portfolio of Coursework for Short Option**

Proposed Minimum of 5 pieces of coursework eg.

- Case Study (40 %)
- 2 Assignments (possibly 1 written and 1 practical) (30 %)
- Survey inc. questionnaire and interview (20 %)
- Self Evaluation (10 %)

## Portfolio of Coursework for Long Option

Proposed Minimum of 9 pieces of coursework  
(possibly 3 from each term) eg.

- Project/Case Study-1,500 words max.  
(40 %)
- 3 Written Assignments (30 %)
- Survey inc. questionnaire and interview  
(15 %)
- Self Evaluation (5 %)
- Practical Assignment/Skills Test (10%)

### Tourism Awareness Programme

#### Proposed Project Brief

- Candidates may take a wide view of the tourism syllabus in their project or concentrate on a specific aspect.
- The project may take any format (visual, written etc) considered appropriate to the topic selected, but the introduction, aims and objectives and conclusions should be written.
- A proposed marking scheme is outlined on the project assessment form attached; each project could be assessed internally according to this marking scheme.
- Proposed grading for this module:
